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### Introduction

As part of our portfolio of Council managed bus shelters, there are 4 former tram stop shelters. The shelter at 2R Frenchmans Road is listed as a heritage item on the Randwick Local Environmental Plan (LEP), 2012.

This report outlines the planned maintenance program for the Council managed, former tram stop shelters that are being used as bus shelters.

### Issues

Randwick Council has an operational policy to install bus seats at bus stops to provide an opportunity for bus patrons to sit whilst waiting for a bus. At certain bus stops, Council has installed bus shelters to also offer limited protection from the elements.

Randwick Council has an agreement with JCDecaux to provide advertising bus shelters along main roads and bus routes. The agreement involves the installation and maintenance of the bus shelter at no cost to Council.

For bus routes along local roads, Randwick Council has been purchasing the bus shelters. For these shelters, Council is responsible for the maintenance costs.

Over the last decade, Council has installed numerous non advertising bus shelters at suitable bus stops located on bus routes along local roads. There are 24 of these Council managed bus shelters located throughout the City. A list of the bus shelters is shown in attachment 1. The bus shelters vary in type, age and style and have different maintenance requirements.

In more recent times, we have been installing a lightweight non advertising bus shelter by JCDecaux. A maintenance plan is offered for these shelters and maintenance is undertaken by JCDecaux. However, for the other types of bus shelters, the maintenance is undertaken by Council staff or contractors engaged for specific tasks.

### Former Tram Stop Shelters

There are 4 former trams stop shelters at our bus stops in Clovelly, Coogee and Randwick. These shelters are of heritage significance and the shelter at 2R Frenchmans road listed a heritage item within the Randwick LEP, 2012. The shelters are timber framed structures with terracotta tiled roofs for 3 and a corrugated roof on the other.

The Clovelly Beach shelter was renovated recently following damage by a vehicle crashing into the shelter. However, there has been no major restoration undertaken to the other 'Tram' shelters other than the regular graffiti removal and minor maintenance.

It is planned to undertake a thorough investigation of the roof tiles, gutter and timber elements of these structures to determine any necessary restorative maintenance.

Following any restorative maintenance, it is planned to paint the timber elements to preserve the timber. Any identified work to the heritage shelter will be planned and undertaken in accordance with the requirements of the Randwick LEP, 2012. To undertake this work, access to the shelters will be restricted for the duration of the work. Notices informing the public of the works will be placed at the shelters with adequate notification prior to the commencement of the work.

The works are planned to commence in late April or early June 2017.

### **Relationship to City Plan**

### **Financial impact statement**

The planned maintenance work will be funded from the existing 2016-17 operational budget.

### **Conclusion**

It is proposed to undertake an assessment and undertake the necessary maintenance for the bus shelters that were formerly tram stop shelters. This work will involve restricting access to the shelters whilst the assessment is being undertaken and the maintenance work completed. Advanced notice of the proposed work will be provided to patrons by erecting notices within the bus shelters.

The work is planned to commence in late April or early June 2017. It is planned to commence with the heritage shelter located at Frenchmans Road followed by the shelters at Coogee Beach.
