

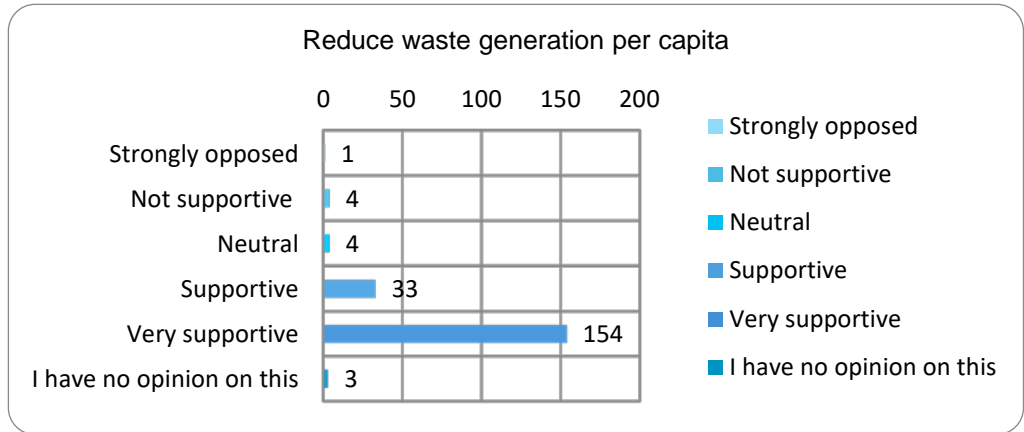

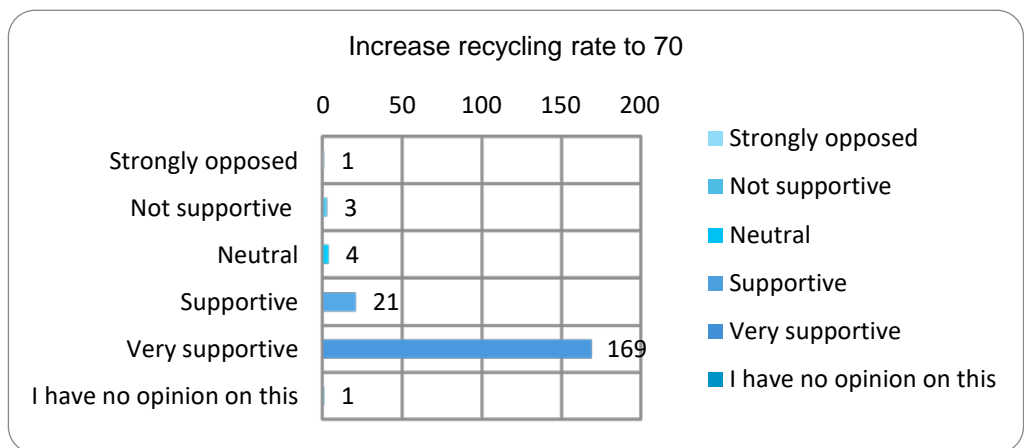

1. How supportive are you of the targets set by the Draft Waste Management Strategy?

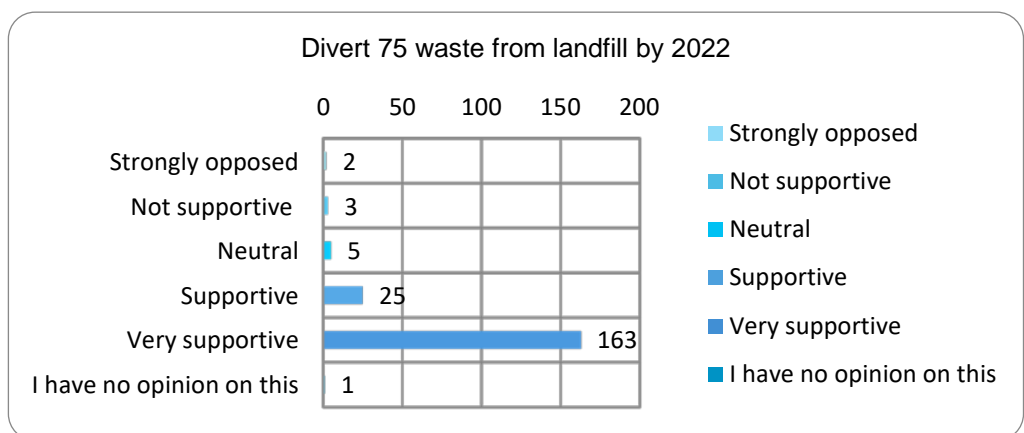

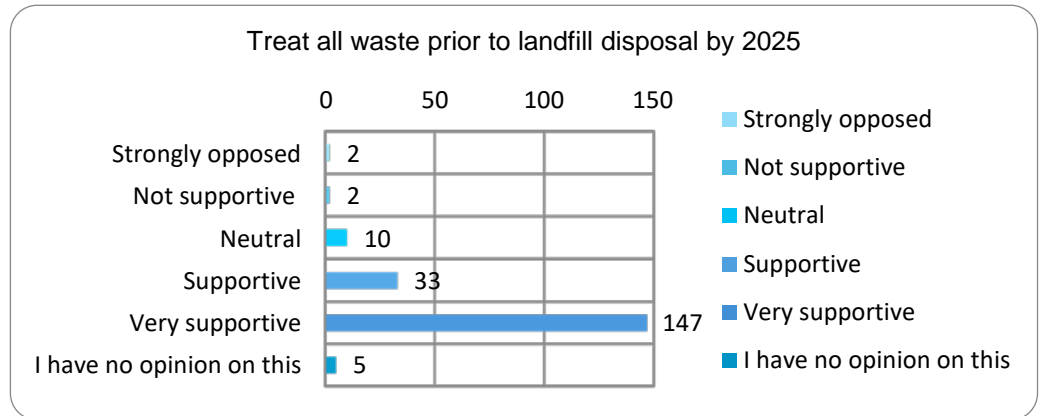

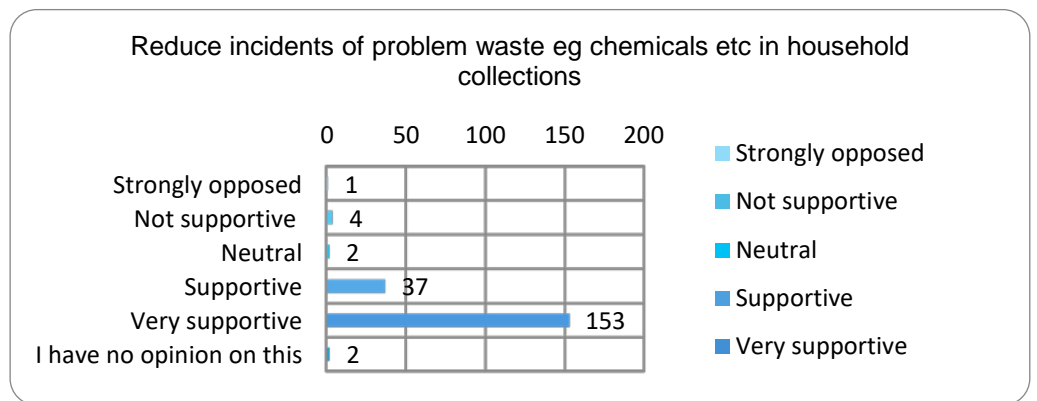

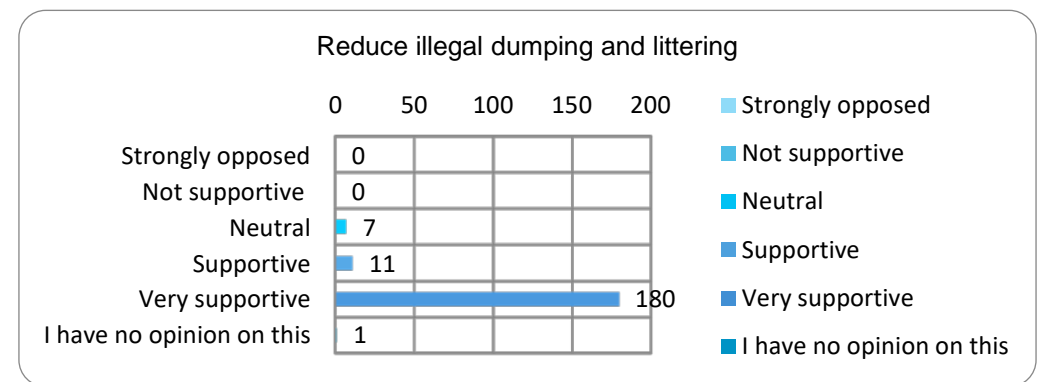

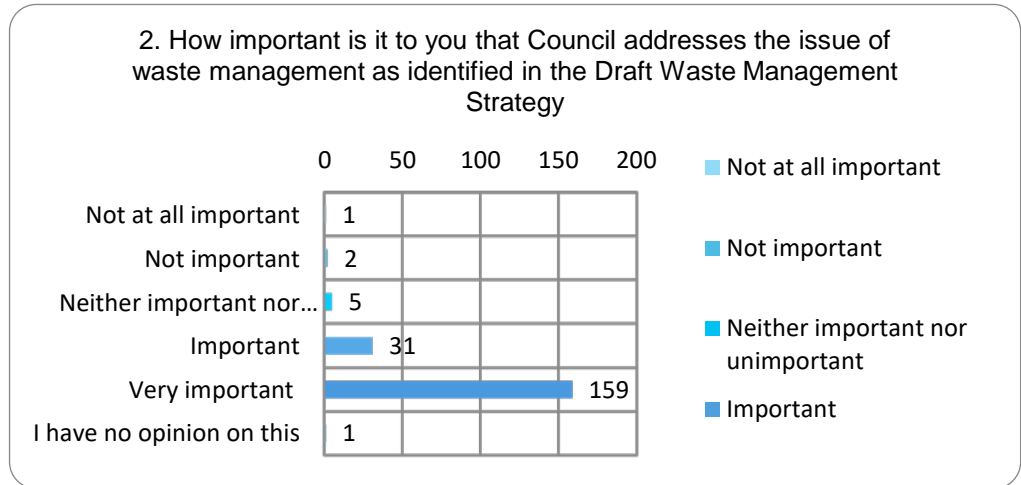

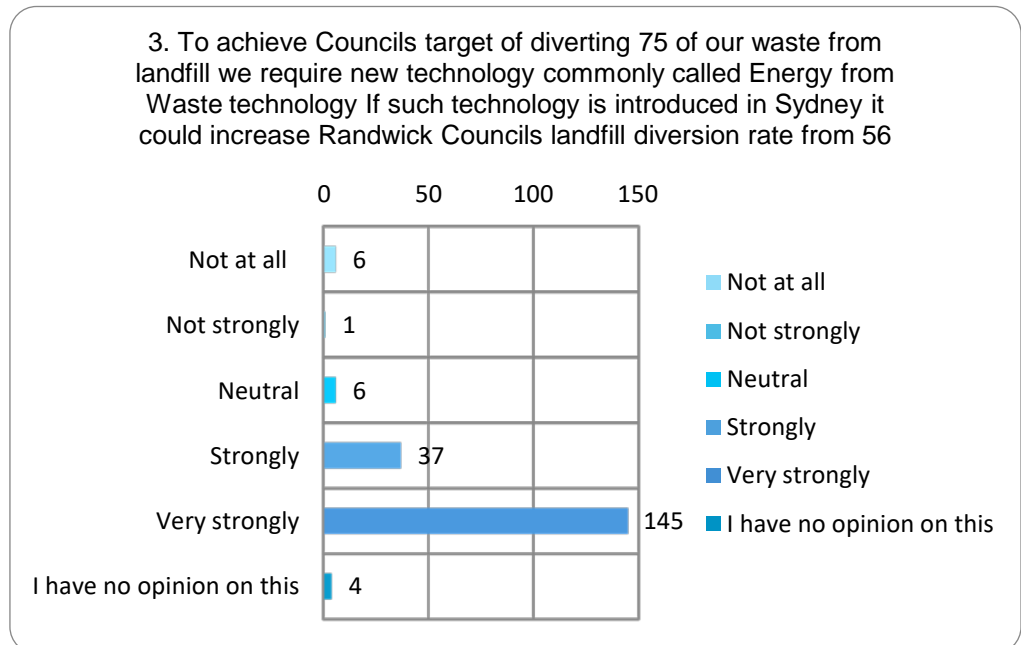
