Flood modelling was conducted incorporating the Light Rail, stabling yard, the increase in levee height and ARR 2016 methodology (more accurate rainfall data and patterns).	Note	
5.2	Based on this new modelling, the number of properties flooded above floor level for the 100 year ARI went from 596 to 328 .	Note	
5.3	Annual Average Damages dropped from \$9.5M to \$4M .	Note	
5.4	Different flood mitigation options were investigated (including structural and non-structural measures). The only two structural measures feasible are the management of blockage at Gardeners Rd culvert (Option J) and a potential upgrade of the culverts at Gardeners Rd (Option I).	Note
