Also the applicant is a private citizen and not an incorporated community organisation therefore is ineligible to seek funds over \$1,000. |
| Aged Care Psychiatry Services | <u>Ageing with Purpose</u> Cash funds to hold a free half day public health forum. The forum aims to promote healthy lifestyles by providing awareness of strategies to reduce risk factors for psychosocial distress and memory disorders as we age. | \$0.00 | \$6,681.82 | C | The applicant is a NSW Government Department and is not a community organisation. This is outside the Cultural and Community Grant Guidelines. |

The applicant seeks funds to provide a community service on an individual basis. Therefore an application to the Community Partnership Program is more appropriate. |
| BIKEast Incorporated | <u>Cycling Without Age Program</u> Cash funds to purchase a 2nd trishaw (multi-seat bicycle) to expand a program to help older persons to get back on bicycles. | \$0.00 | \$17,090.00 | C | The project is ineligible because funding is requested solely to purchase equipment only (trishaw) item, which is outside the Cultural and Community Grant Guidelines. |

| Magic Moments Foundation – Sydney Basket Brigade | <u>Sydney Basket Brigade – bringing hope to people who need it most at Christmas time in Sydney</u> This Sydney wide program works with volunteers and community organisations to anonymously deliver baskets filled with food, clothing to people in need. Cash funds to purchase non-perishable foods, clothing and toys to be distributed at Christmas time to persons in need across Sydney | \$0.00 | \$909.91 | C | The project is ineligible because activities (grocery and item packing) will be held outside Randwick LGA (Chullora), and application is only to purchase items; both of which are outside the Cultural and Community Grant guidelines. Project is also a broad Sydney wide program that has not demonstrated strong connection to Randwick residents relative to other applications. |
| Russian Speaking Jewish Community Association | <u>Limmud FSU – Former Soviet Union</u> is a festival, to be held at UNSW, to showcase the history and culture of people from the former Soviet Union countries, and the contribution of the Russian speaking immigrants to Australian Society. Cash funds towards presenter’s accommodation, materials for participants, presenter entrance subsidy, and technical support for the festival. | \$0.00 | \$6,363.64 | C | The project is ineligible because the applicant is charging access to the event which is outside the Cultural and Community Grant Guidelines. The project also has not demonstrated strong connection to Randwick residents, relative to other applications, because the festival is attracting people from across Australia. |
| The Polish School of Sydney | <u>Prince Henry Centre venue hire</u> In-kind funds to hold a 15 year anniversary ball for their volunteers, parents and students. | \$3,295.45 | \$0.00 | C | The application is ineligible because the proposed event is for a single interest group, which is outside the Cultural and Community Grant Guidelines. Whilst the applicant is based in Randwick, the project has not demonstrated strong connection to Randwick residents, relative to other applications because its students come from across Sydney. |
